Resolution on Conferment of the title Chairman Emeritus on Hon. Yasuhiro Nakasone, Founder of the Asia Pacific Parliamentary Forum

Recalling that from 13 to 15 January 1993, we saw the birth of a regional parliamentary organization, which is now the Asia-Pacific Parliamentary Forum, in Tokyo, Japan under the leadership of Hon. Yasuhiro Nakasone, former Prime Minister of Japan;
